NEW Simulation Course at Holland Bloorview

- 1-day in-person group training session
- CMA-2 practice-outing (~ 2.5 hours) with simulated patient with a recovering ABI
- Post-outing meeting with simulated patient and parents (~1 hour)
- Classroom-based debrief postassessment for CMA-2 results interpretation and goal setting
- CMA-2 certification test (on-line) after course completion

ABOUT

What: Two training components (on-line *plus* one day Simulation (SIM) session at Holland Bloorview)

Research Evaluations: CMA-2 scoring and confidence rating completed prior to online training, and before and after SIM course (each evaluation takes ~30 minutes). Feedback guestionnaires completed for both components.
