



PARTICIPATE IN A RESEARCH STUDY!

ABOUT

What: Two training components (on-line *plus* one day Simulation (SIM) session at Holland Bloorview)

Research Evaluations: CMA-2 scoring and confidence rating completed prior to online training, and before and after SIM course (each evaluation takes ~30 minutes). Feedback questionnaires completed for both components.

Who: OTs/PTs working at least 1 day/week with youth with Acquired Brain Injury and who have never done any formal CMA/CMA-2 training (permitted to have attended a CMA-2 outing as an observer only)

When: Online modules will be provided 6 – 8 weeks prior to SIM training that will be held on **Monday, March 25th, 2019**

Where: Holland Bloorview Conference Centre

Why: To see whether a new CMA-2 online training program is effective in improving accuracy and confidence in scoring the CMA-2

NEW Simulation Course at Holland Bloorview

- ✓ 1-day in-person group training session
- ✓ CMA-2 practice-outing (~ 2.5 hours) with simulated patient with a recovering ABI
- ✓ Post-outing meeting with simulated patient and parents (~1 hour)
- ✓ Classroom-based debrief post-assessment for CMA-2 results interpretation and goal setting
- ✓ CMA-2 certification test (on-line) after course completion
