



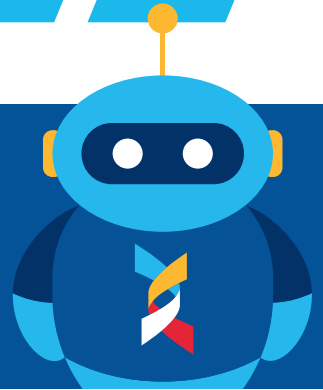
At CureDuchenne, we have a new framework for helping patients, families and caregivers understand the complexities of Duchenne.
